

The Clarkston Farm and Garden Club has designed and maintained the plantings at the library for over 52 years. The current design is a series of small gardens based on children's books such as "The Frog Prince", "The Secret Garden", "The Giving Tree", and "Peter Rabbit". Some of the features are a "Rosie the Riveter" rose planted by the Rosie the Riveter Organization to honor a woman who was once a Rosie the Riveter worker. A frog fountain, a butterfly bench, and a "sprout" sculpture were designed and made by a group of students from the Center of Creative Studies in Detroit. The Roots and Fruits nursery includes edible and medicinal plants for patrons of the library to harvest. Sedum ground cover is planted on the steps to the library as it is a difficult place to water and requires minimal maintenance.
